Dear Rosedale Families,

The start of the new year has brought great hope for this pandemic to end and to resume life as normal. Although we are beginning to see the light at the end of the tunnel now that a vaccine has been approved, we are still suffering the effects of high positive COVID-19 cases in our county. Our goal remains to get staff and students back to in-person instruction as soon as possible; however, when making decisions about when and how to resume in-person instruction we must consider how the virus spread affects our organization. This evening the Board of Trustees established the following timeline for resuming in-person instruction:

Grades/Programs	Date
All Special Day Classes, TK-2nd grade	Tuesday, January 19, 2021
3rd-6th grade	Monday, February 1, 2021
7th and 8th grade	Tuesday, February 9, 2021

Additional Information

Raptor Screening

Tomorrow we will resume the daily health screening. We appreciate each of you taking a few minutes in the morning to check the health of your child and keeping them home when needed. This important step helps identify students who may need to stay home and prevents our classrooms from being placed on quarantine. If your student is in Special Day Classes or TK-2nd grade, please begin answering the health screening **tomorrow** (Wednesday, Jan 13). If your child is not part of the group returning next week, you may complete the screening for your child, but it is not yet required. Completing the screening helps our staff take care of any needed exclusions prior to school resuming.

When completing the screening, if you answer YES to one or more questions, any additional information you could include in the notes section would be most appreciated. We will continue to add additional grade levels for the daily health screening prior to the week that each grade level returns to on campus instruction. Please be on the lookout for an email from Raptor Screening each morning. If you forget first thing in the morning, it's not too late. Please complete it when you remember.

Distance Learning Option

If you choose to continue, or decide to move your student into Distance Learning, please know that we are asking you to commit to your student remaining in Distance Learning until the end of the 3rd quarter (March 5, 2021). At that time you can either choose to have your student remain in Distance Learning, or return to In-Person instruction for the 4th quarter.

In-Person Option

Students who need to be absent for any reason other than school exclusions, who are rostered for In-Person instruction may not be participating in the Distance Learning program during their absence. Please contact your school office about specifics for excused and unexcused absences. If classes are quarantined, the students will return to Distance Learning as a class until the duration of time has passed that they are able to return to In-Person instruction (approximately 14 calendar days).
