Board Rules limit Public Comment Speakers to 15 at any single meeting, and 20 minutes for any single topic. Each speaker is limited to a three-minute presentation.

Individuals who wish to speak before the Board must submit their request **prior** to the start of the meeting. Speakers must sign up as they enter the boardroom and hand their request to Merrill Clanton, Executive Assistant to the Superintendent.

The meeting location is wheelchair accessible. Speakers needing any disability related or language accommodation should notify the Board Secretary's Office a minimum of 24 hours in advance of the meeting to arrange for accommodation, and inform staff upon arrival.
